Registration:

Enclosed please find a copy of the registration form. **All students new & continuing** need to fill this form out completely, including the liability before his or her first class. Summer tuition is non-refundable, therefore, make-up any class you miss. You can pay cash or make your checks payable to NVDC or Napa Valley Dance Center. Please register as soon as possible, as classes fill up quickly. Please note that students will not be registered or allowed to attend their first class with incomplete paperwork, incorrect payment or if you have an **outstanding balance** from past sessions.

In the classroom:

No food, gum, or drinks allowed in the classroom (please bring water). Proper dance clothes and shoes are required for all dance classes. Proper dance attire is listed below. **Hair should be neatly secured in a pony tail, bun, or French braid** so that it isn't a distraction in class.

Proper dance attire:

Ballet: Pink tights, solid color leotard, ballet skirt, and ballet shoes. Hair secured in a ponytail, bun, or French braid (off your face).

Jazz & Tap: Dance pants or shorts, tight fitting top or leotard. **No street clothes** such as sweatshirts, jeans, baggy pants, shorts, pajama pants, etc. Tap or Jazz shoes required. Hair secured in ponytail, bun, or French braid.

Boys: mesh athletic shorts or pants, solid color t-shirts. No street clothes such as baggy pants, sweatshirts, jeans, pajama pants, etc. Appropriate dance shoes required.

Just a word about performing:

Performances are not mandatory; however they play an important role in dance education and are definitely encouraged! Performing enriches a dancer in so many ways, improving self discipline and building confidence and overcoming shyness.

Please keep this information along with the class schedule for make-up classes. Remember to get your registration form in as soon as possible. *If you choose not to dance for the 6 week summer session you can send in September's tuition to reserve your space for the new fall session!
